John 3:14-18

1. What part of the text/message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged? Intrigued? Challenged?
2. Explain the picture of rescue that Jesus uses in John 3:14-15. How does Moses raising the serpent in the wilderness mirror what Jesus came to do on the cross? How does the picture of "look and live" challenge self-reliance in matters of salvation?
3. Look at John 3:16 and discuss how someone might be able to use this one verse to explain the gospel message to a non-Christian.
4. Why is it important to include the bad news (perishing and condemnation) in order to truthfully explain the good news of the Gospel? In what ways are we sometimes tempted to overlook the reality of God's judgment?
5. How does John 3:18 explain the urgency of the gospel message?

Bonus Question: Look through the songs that we sang on Sunday (and in particular, the songs "Completely Done" and "And Can It Be"). Take time to reflect and to praise God for His amazing love!
