

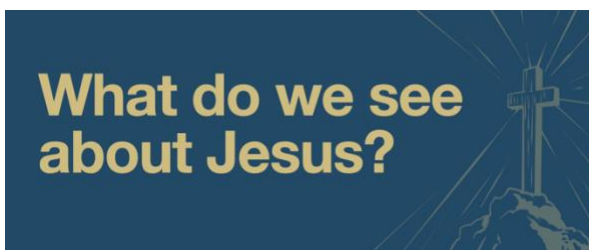

1. How does John 1:4-5, 9 help our understanding of the Light in John 3:19–21?
2. What does John 3:19 mean when it says people loved the darkness rather than the light? Why do people find comfort in darkness and avoid the light, according to this passage and your experience?
3. In what areas of your life do you feel tempted to retreat into darkness? How does it feel to bring hidden sins into the light of God's grace?
4. What does "dwelling in the light" look like practically for a believer? How is community crucial to helping us stay in the light?
5. How can we share the light of Christ with those who fear or reject it? What can believers do to prayerfully and powerfully shine Christ's light in a dark world?
