He Must Increase
John 3:22-36

1. What does John 3:27 teach us about the source of all good things in our lives? What good things in your life are you tempted to take credit for, instead of being thankful to God?
2. How does John's analogy of the bridegroom and friend help us understand his ministry and mission? In what ways can we point others to Jesus like John the Baptist did?
3. How should you apply the words of John the Baptist to your life – “He must increase, but I must decrease”?

How does C.S. Lewis' definition of humility—“Humility is not thinking less of yourself, it's thinking of yourself less.”— help you apply this truth in your life?

4. How does John's portrait of Jesus (He is above all, and is given all - vs. 31-35) help you to see the ultimate place Jesus has as the Son of God?
5. What's the link between trust and obedience (vs 36)? What does it mean for you personally to believe in the Son AND obey Him?

What do we see about Jesus?

Jesus is above all, testifies to Truth, and has been given all by the Father. Believe in His name.
