
June 22nd, 2025 *I John 4:7-16*Love One Another

- 1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged? Intrigued? Challenged?
- 2. In verses 7-8, how does understanding that "God is love" challenge or comfort you personally?
- 3. In verses 9-10, how does the sending of Jesus shape our understanding of what real love looks like?
 - How might this picture of love reshape how you approach difficult relationships?
- 4. John says, "Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another." (v. 11) What does this look like practically in your group, church, or family?

- 5. In verses 13-16, what does it mean to "abide" in God's love, and how do we know if we're actually doing it?
- As you think about abiding in the love of God, consider John 15:9-11 and Jude vv. 1-2, 20-21. What spiritual practices help you abide and keep yourself in the love of God? What gets in the way?

Personal Reflection and Prayer

- Where do you most need to experience God's love afresh right now?
- What might change in your life if you more deeply believed you are loved by God?
