


July 6th, 2025 *Romans 15:1-7*Welcome One Another

- 2. How does this passage challenge a consumer mindset, that Church "is about me and meeting my needs," represented in many modern churches? What are signs that someone is approaching church with a "one-another mindset" instead?
- 3. How is "pleasing our neighbor" (in vs. 2) different from people-pleasing? What should the goal of pleasing our neighbor be, according to Romans 15:1-7?
- 4. How does Christ's willingness to not please Himself deepen your understanding of the gospel?
- 5. According to verses 5–6, what kind of unity does God desire among believers? What does it look like in the church to experience a harmony as we "with one voice glorify God"?
- 6. When have you experienced being welcomed (or not welcomed) by someone in the church? How did that affect you?
- 7. How can you practice a more "Christ-shaped" motivation in your relationships to build up and welcome others?
