


## July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Galatians 5:25-6:5 "Carrying One Another's Burdens as Christ Carried Yours"

- 4. How do we guard ourselves from pride as we seek to "carry one another's burdens?" When are you most tempted to think "you are something" (v.3)?
- 5. What's the difference between "burdens" in vs. 2 and "load" in vs. 5? Why is the difference important?
- 6. How can we foster a culture where restoration is normal and not shameful? How can we avoid judgmentalism while at the same time addressing sin? How can we practically step in to carry one another's burdens?
