



**Psalm 96 — “Declare His Glory Among the Nations”

**Opening Discussion**

1. What stands out to you most as you read Psalm 96?
2. What part of the message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged? Intrigued? Challenged?

**Digging Deeper — Discussion Questions**

**1. Verses 1–3:**

- Why do you think the psalmist emphasizes “all the earth” in calling for worship?
- What does it mean to “declare His glory among the nations”? How does this connect worship and mission?

**2. Verses 4–6:**

- What contrasts are drawn between God and the idols of the nations?
- Where you tempted to give yourself to those things that are “weightless”?

**3. Verses 7–13:**

- What do these verses teach about the posture and attitude of true worship?  
Compare this with II Cor. 3:16-18 - How is that related to worshipping the Lord in the splendor of holiness?
- What did Justin mean when he said, “We cannot give away what we don’t have”?  
How is it related to our responses to beholding God’s glory (We will sing! We will daily declare Him! We will lead all families to ascribe to the LORD glory! We will celebrate the LORD’s reign!)

### **Application Questions**

1. How were you challenged by the closing illustration? (No reserves — No retreats — No regrets)
2. Justin asked, “Are you a faithful worshiper?” How are you growing as to what that means?
